Type 1 diabetes (T1D) is a chronic autoimmune disease in which a person's pancreas stops producing insulin. Anyone can be diagnosed with T1D at any age, and its onset has nothing to do with diet or lifestyle. People living with T1D must take insulin by injection or insulin pump to survive. There are currently no cures. Breakthrough T1D is working to change that.
