Event Day Roles and Positions

 □ I have checked the volunteer role(s) I'm interested in being assigned. □ I don't have a preference, please assign me where needed.
□ Set-Up 6:30 – 9:30 a.m. Unload equipment, signage and supplies; deliver to designated tents, affix table coverings to tables, and place final signage.
□ Volunteer Check-In 7 – 9 a.m. Check in volunteers and confirm their assignment, provide a JDRF One Walk volunteer t-shirt, and Give direction where volunteer role is located.
□ Greeter 8:30 – 10:30 a.m. Welcome walkers as they enter the site from parking lot(s), provide direction to Check-In and V1P Check-In to turn in pledges and/or receive a JDRF Walk t-shirt ticket, and ensure walkers have pledges in completed pledge collection envelope before proceeding to Check-In
□ Water Station 8:30 – 11:30 a.m. Hand water and snacks to walkers as they approach Water Station, cheer on walkers and direct them along the route as needed.
□ Check-In 8:30 a.m. – Noon You must be 18 or older to assist with Check-In. Collect walker pledges and registration forms, Acknowledge and celebrate walkers turning in \$500+!, and distribute t-shirt tickets to walkers raising \$100+ and direct to T-Shirt Tent.
□ Food and Beverage 8:30 a.m. − 1 p.m. Assist in serving food and beverages.
□ T-Shirt Distribution 9 a.m. − 1 p.m. Distribute JDRF One Walk t-shirts to walkers raising \$100+, and distribute special gift to walkers with T1D.
□ Activities Tent 9 a.m. − 1 p.m. Assist children with tattoos, arts and crafts, and other activities.
□ Step and Repeat Banner 9 a.m. − 1 p.m. Assist walkers in selecting fun accessories to wear for a photo opportunity in front of JDRF One Walk Step and Repeat banner, take their photo (with their camera or phone).
□ Mission Tent 9:30 a.m. − Noon Answer basic questions about JDRF, JDRF-funded research, local chapter activities and JDRF's Ride program; provide print information on these topics, sign up interested walkers to become a JDRF Advocate, and provide first time walker gifts to families walking with JDRF for the first time.
□ Route Cheerleader 9:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Spread out along the Walk Route to cheer on, thank and motivate walkers.
□ Break Down Noon to 2 p.m. Remove table coverings, break down cardboard, pick up signage and any trash on site and along the Walk route, load signage, supplies, etc.
