AP APPLE Surveillance Study | Type 1 Diabetes

What Is This Study About?

We are recruiting boys and girls who are 11 or 12 years old, going through puberty, and have been diagnosed with type 1 diabetes (T1D) for a 2-year research study. We are assessing changes in insulin resistance, glucose response, and psychosocial factors that are related to adolescent T1D management and glycemic control during their pubertal stages.

Study Requirements

- 4 in-person visits
- 15 phone or email check-in visits
- Hemoglobin A1c ≥10%
- All study supplies provided at no cost
