Official rules- An Amazing Poker Run Benefiting JDRF

- 1. Players will pick up playing cards at The Lifthouse to start their poker run. An email will be sent out 24-48 hours after any \$60 donation to get you started. It will have a schedule of the event and a link to the map of locations. At each stop, one care will be drawn from a bag or on table of one full deck of poker cards. The Poker Stop Event staff will place a unique stamp on the score card for the rank and suit of card drawn. The playing card will be returned into the deck. Any ties will be chosen by high card in hand. Any 5 card ties will be decided by a randomizer pulled high card or with social distance pulled by players if possible.
- 2. The last stop at Wingers Ale House in Bountiful, Ut the players will pick last card and turn in playing card with name on it.
- 3. Participants will have till 4:30 PM MST, April 17, 2021 to get card turned in.
- 4. The award ceremony will be done virtually, and award arrangements will be made via email or phone.
- 5. The following will be used to rank scored hands. Prizes will be given for best and worst hands. We will use **Standard Poker Hand Ranking**. There are 52 cards in a pack and the ranking of the individual cars, for high to low, is ace, king, queen, jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, Joker. There is no ranking between the suits- for example king of hearts and the king of spades are equal and the joker card is wild.

A poker hand consists of 5 cards, and to encourage extra donations each extra \$60 donated you will receive an extra card. Max 2 extra cards- for example donate \$120 you will be able to pull 1 extra card at the last stop, \$180 donated 2 extra cards. Donation of \$240 you will NOT get another card. Those who donate to get extra cards will have to throw out extra pulls to make the best hand of 5 cards. A listing below ranking highest to lowest categories of hands. Between hands in the same category, the rank of the individual cards will decide which hand is better.
