WALK DAY SCHEDULE



9:00 A.M. – GATES OPEN & CHECK-IN BEGINS

Swing by the side entrance near Roca & Martillo to check in and confirm your registration. Everyone must register to join the Walk Day fun. If you're part of Team Village, head straight to your team tent!



9:00 A.M. - WALK DAY FUN

9:45 A.M. – TID PARADE LINE UP

Head over to the Frost Plaza stage for our Opening Ceremonies before the Walk begins! We'll kick things off with the inspiring T1D Parade, celebrating everyone living with T1D and reminding us why we walk.



10:30 A.M. – RIBBON CUTTING & WALK BEGINS

Our Emcee will count us down, and the Walk Chair family will cut the ribbon to kick off the Walk! Grab your team, enjoy the route, and don't forget to snag your Mile of Hope sign to take home!



11:00 A.M. - FINISH LINE PARTY BEGINS

FUNDRAISING TIPS & TRICKS



The Breakthrough T1D Walk experience celebrates the T1D journeys and the hard work that is accomplished by T1Ds along with their support team. We also want to celebrate the fundraising efforts driven by individuals and teams that continue to provide resources for T1D research for advancements and a cure!

Whether this is your very first Walk or you're a Walk pro, check out these tips and tricks to get your team off and running. We've outlined some fundraising ideas but you can ABSOLUTELY create your own. Walk is all about finding a plan that works for your team.

QUICK FUNDRAISING TIPS

- Show your commitment! Make your own donation of \$50, \$100 or more.
 Customize your personal fundraising page in your Walk Participant Center and find all the tools you need for fundraising success, including reaching out on social media
- ASK five family members, local businesses, and/or coworkers for \$25 each.
 Helpful Tip: Send requests from your Participant Center to give people a secure way to make a credit card donation. We've provided sample fundraising letters in your Participant Center to help you!
- ASK five people you know from your extracurricular sports team, child's school, or place of worship to donate \$20 each.
- Turn it around! ASK someone whose cause you have supported for \$25 or more.
- Work your social network and you will easily raise \$150. Reach out through Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and any other social media you use to let people know why you're participating in the Breakthrough T1D Walk. Make it personal. And be sure to use your Participant Center to create a Facebook Fundraiser!

ENGAGING EMPLOYERS



Engaging your employer is a quick and easy way to recruit team members and increase fundraising! If you have any questions and/or would like additional support, please feel free to contact a Breakthrough T1D staff member; their contact information is at the end of this packet.

Here are a few quick and easy ways you can involve your employer:

- Utilize any matching gift program your company offers & encourage your colleagues to as well.
- Ask your company if they would be interested in sponsoring the event.
 Sponsorship opportunities range from \$1,000 \$25,000, and it can all be credited to your team fundraising!
- · Ask your colleagues to join your team!
- Does your company offer any sort of community volunteer program? This is a
 great way to engage. Many companies offer employees several paid hours to
 volunteer at events.
- Sell paper sneakers around the office for quick & easy fundraising. A
 Breakthrough T1D staff member can supply the materials free of charge!

ENGAGING SCHOOLS



Engaging your school is a great way to recruit team members, have the school support your child with T1D, and increase fundraising! Walk is also a great opportunity for obtaining community service hours for students in need of them. Here are a few quick and easy ways you can involve your school:

SPIRIT DAY/WEEK:

Show your school spirit and raise funds! Students and staff make a donation of \$1, \$3 or \$5 (or any amount you decide) and participate in dress up days like:

- · Superhero day
- · Storybook character day
- Dress in blue day (blue symbolizes Diabetes Awareness)
- · Crazy hat day
- · Pajama day
- · Dress down day
- Sports day

THONS:

Have some fun or reach a fitness or academic goal! Select your "thon" and set your goal (e.g. number of hours danced, number of books read, number of laps, etc.). Students ask for pledges for each hour they dance, each book they read, each lap they complete, etc.

- Dance-a-thon
- · Zumba-thon
- · Bike-a-thon or trike-a-thon
- · Read-a-thon

THE CLASSICS:

These tried-and-true fundraisers are sure to raise valuable research dollars.

- Bake sale
- · Car wash
- Lemonade stand
- · Garage sale
- In honor of Back to School, Halloween, Homecoming, and Veteran's Day sell flowers, cards, school swag or other items.

HAVE A SALE:

Do your students have services or items that can be turned into donations?


- "Sell" tutoring, handmade crafts, babysitting, or other chores link cutting grass, or raking leaves. This fundraiser is great for high school students!
- Host a school garage sale—families bring their things to the school parking lot, and all proceeds donated.
- Create and sell a kids cookbook—everyone turns in their favorite recipe, compile it into book/e-book and sell

SPORTS TOURNAMENT:

Charge an entry fee for teams to compete in a basketball, volleyball, kickball, or other tournament. Get coaches, teachers, and parents to participate or compete against students!

- · Students vs. Students
- · Staff vs. Parents
- Students vs. Teachers

Sell popcorn, drinks and more and donate the proceeds.

Customize your fundraising page

Customize your fundraising page with a message about why you raise money for 1,T1D research. Update your photo and add a fun sticker or frame!

Personalize your experience by adding pictures or videos easily from your camera roll.

Send texts, emails and messages to ask for support

Extend your fundraising reach and promotion by creating a QR code or sending updates through Facebook, email, SMS or LinkedIn.



Schedule periodic posts on LinkedIn to automatically update your supporters leading up to your event day.

Expand Your Reach Amplify your impact by linking your Breakthrough T1D fundraising page to Facebook. Participants who use Facebook Fundraisers raise five times more on average.



Deposit Checks and Track Fundraising Progress Use the mobile check deposit feature and watch your donations appear on your fundraising thermometer in real time. No more printing forms or mailing in checks! Earn badges as you fundraise, too!



Be the First to Know! We'll communicate about your event day and send important updates through the app. Be sure to say "yes" to allowing app push notifications, so you are always in the know!

Getting Started is as Easy as 1–2–3!

- 1. Simply scan the QR code or visit the Apple App Store or Google Play on your device.
- 2. Search for "Breakthrough T1D Fundraising," and follow the steps to download and launch the app.
- 3. Log in with the username and password you created during registration.










Breakthrough T1D Fundraising App

Mobile Check Deposit

Please use the Walk App to deposit checks. Checks should be made out to "Breakthrough T1D". We are not collecting checks or cash on Walk Day.

You can deposit checks right from your phone using the Breakthrough T1D Fundraising app! Follow these simple step-by-step instructions.

- 1. Download the Breakthrough T1D Fundraising App.
- **2.** Log in to the app using the same credentials you use for your registered Breakthrough T1D fundraising event.
- 3. Click on the Donations tab at the bottom of the app.
- 4. Select Enter Donations and click on Check Deposit.
- 5. Select Front Scan to take a picture of the front of the check and Back Scan to capture an image of the back of the check. Be sure to write For Deposit Only on the check endorsement line. Please write in dark ink, do not use a stamp.
- 6. Enter the amount for the check and click Next.
- 7. Ensure the donor's first name, last name, if the donation should be anonymous, and address populate correctly into the required fields. It is optional to enter the donor's email. Click **Submit**.
- **8.** Success! You should now see the deposit confirmation screen. The donation will be reflected on your fundraising page within 24-48 business hours.
